



**Transfer Articulation Agreement
between
STATE UNIVERSITY OF NEW YORK AT COBLESKILL
and
SUFFOLK COUNTY COMMUNITY COLLEGE**

July 2006

This formal articulation agreement between Suffolk County Community College and State University of New York College at Cobleskill is intended to facilitate the process of transfer from Suffolk County Community College to SUNY Cobleskill.

Specifically, this agreement is intended for students at Suffolk County Community College who want to transfer into the Histotechnology option of the Medical Laboratory Technology Program at SUNY Cobleskill.


Terms of the Agreement

1. Students from Suffolk County Community College who complete the pre-requisites as specified in Addendum A, with a minimum overall grade point average of 2.5 for the first year of study, will be guaranteed acceptance to SUNY Cobleskill as a second year student.
2. This guarantee provides the opportunity to complete the Cobleskill Associate in Applied Science degree in MLT-Histotechnology option, normally requiring no more than one year of academic work at Cobleskill, including a summer clinical rotation at one of our affiliate sites.
3. Courses with grades of C or better will be accepted for transfer credit. Courses with C- or D+ may be accepted for elective credit only.
4. Students who do not meet the requirements of this agreement will also be considered for admission. They will be evaluated on an individual basis.


This agreement will become effective on July 10, 2006. It will be reviewed for renewal by both institutions prior to July 10, 2011.



1. BIO 150 & BIO 152 Modern Biology I & II (another 4 credit Biology course may be substituted w/approval from Histo Program Director)	8 Credit Hours
2. CHE 133 & CHE 134 College Chemistry I & II	8 Credit Hours
3. ENG 101 Standard Freshman Composition	3 Credit Hours
4. Mathematics (MAT 111 Algebra II or MAT 121, 124, 125, or higher)	3-4 Credit Hours
5. Social Sciences (Course must satisfy SUNY Board of Trustees General Education Social Science Category)	3 Credit Hours
6. Physical Education	1 Credit Hour
7. Two courses that will satisfy two additional SUNY General Education categories not already fulfilled.	6 Credit Hours
